A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BUFFALO, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA DESIGNATING THE SOUTH BUFFALO TOWNSHIP VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY AND RELIEF ASSOCIATION AS THE OFFICIAL FIRE COMPANY TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION AND RELATED SERVICES TO SOUTH BUFFALO TOWNSHIP; AUTHORIZING ACTIVITIES OF THE FIRE COMPANY, OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE FIRE COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING FIREFIGHTING AND EMS DUTIES.

**WHEREAS,** The Township of South Buffalo, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania has a obligation under the applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of South Buffalo Township; and

**WHEREAS,** The South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association provide various services to the township; and

**WHEREAS,** The supervisors of the Township of South Buffalo are desirous of making a formal designation of the South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association as the official Fire Company for the Township of South Buffalo.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it **RESOLVED** by the Supervisors of the Township of South Buffalo, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, that effective immediately:

1. The South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association, Inc., organized and existing within the Township of South Buffalo, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated as the officially recognized Fire Company for the Township of South Buffalo.

2. The South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association Inc., is hereby authorized to do the following:

- a. To provide any and all services that maybe necessary for the protection of real and personal property and persons situate in South Buffalo Township to include but not be limited to the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous material incidents, and other dangerous situations to which the said Fire Company is dispatched.

- b. To provide non-emergency and public service functions including but not limited to the removal of water from real property or contained within houses and buildings after storms and assisting in the removal, abatement and prevention of damages or injury to persons or real and personal property whether through natural causes or man-made events.
- c. Any and all other legal activities authorized by the applicable Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that would pertain to the South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association Inc.

AS THE OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED FIRE COMPANY TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION AND RELATED SERVICES TO THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BUFFALO; AUTHORIZING ACTIVITIES OF THE FIRE COMPANY, OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE FIRE COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING FIREFIGHTING AND EMS DUTIES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of South Buffalo, and it is hereby RESOLVED by and with the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association Inc., organized and existing in the Township of South Buffalo, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designed as the officially recognized fire company for the township.

**SECTION 2 :** Authorized activities of the South Buffalo Township Volunteer Fire Company and Relief Association Inc.:

- (a) The fire company recognized by the Township is hereby authorized to provide such services as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons situated therein which include, by way of example and not of limitation, the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents, and other dangerous situations.
- (b) The company may also provide non-emergency and public service functions such as, again by the way of example and not of limitation, removing water from property after storms and assisting in the removal, abatement and prevention of damage or injury to persons or property whether through natural causes or man-made situations.
